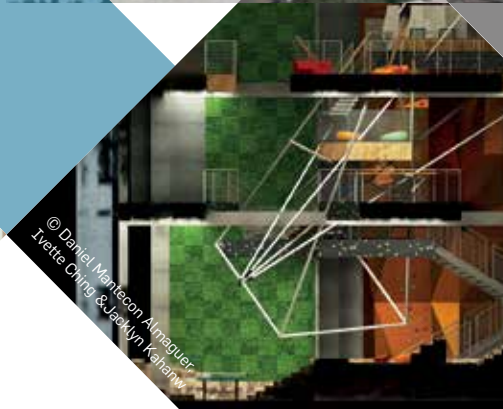
You can also stroll along the Corniche, with its endless string of beach-side cafés and restaurants.
